Fund Profile & Investment Policy

The fund is a directionally biased Long / Short equity fund which will not hesitate to capture equity market beta when conditions allow for it.

Investment Strategy

The portfolio is managed as a long/short hedge fund, focused on extracting alpha returns from the South African equity market. The fund's returns are delivered through fundamental knowledge of South African equities vis-à-vis economic growth and broad economic themes as well as medium to long-term relative valuation opportunities, generating the largest portion of its returns through its directional bias. Relative value pairs, together with absolute longs and shorts seek to stabilize returns in turbulent market conditions, supported by the adjustment to the net exposure.

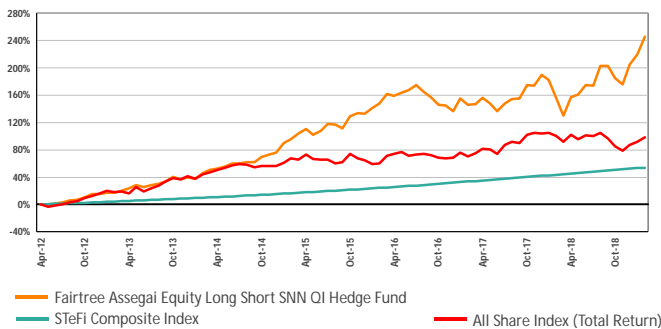
Investment Mandate

The portfolio may use leverage to a maximum of 4.5 times the net asset value of the portfolio. However, the portfolio has set an internal limit to use leverage up to a maximum of 3.5 times the net asset value. Excluded from this calculation shall be the investments in the portfolio solely used to enhance the interest earned by the portfolio.

Mandate limits and constraints:

- The portfolio is precluded from raising any debt funding over and above that achieved in terms of the long/short process;
- No net individual equity position shall exceed 15% of capital;
- Directional exposure limit to 120% of current underlying capital on the long side and up to 20% of current underlying capital on the short side;
- The portfolio shall at all times hold a minimum of 10 equity positions; and
- The portfolio will limit exposure to equities based upon liquidity.

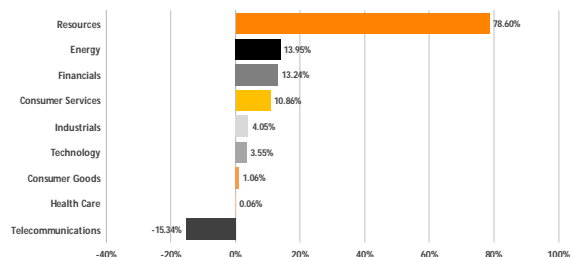

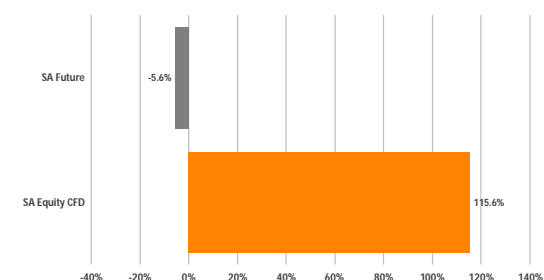
Portfolio Objective

Total Expense Ratio

Market Commentary

The All Share index rose 3.4% in rands during February, but a 5.9% weakening of the local currency meant that the South African market underperformed both MSCI EM (+0.2%) and MSCI World (+3.0%) in USD. Bond yields rose (R186 +15 bps to 8.71%) so the ALBI fell -0.4%, lagging equity indices and cash (+0.5%). Resources (+9.1%) outperformed Industrials (+3.5%) and Financials (-2.1%). By sector, Platinum (+30.2%), Personal Goods (+17.8%) Metals/Mining (+9.9%) and Tobacco (+9.9%) were among the big winners while Mobile Telecom (-3.8%), Life Insurance (-4.0%) General Retail (-4.3%) and Real Estate (-5.5%) were the key underperformers.

Eskom dominated the headlines. First, Ramaphosa's State of the Nation Address (7 Feb) called for the company to be split into three parts. Then, the load shedding began. Finally, Fin Min Mbweni delivered the budget on 20 Feb including R69bn in support over 3 years for Eskom. The fiscal deficit projection was widened to 4.5% from 4.2% of GDP for FY2019/20 and the debt/GDP projection rose. Bond yields rallied on the budget since it was better than investors' low expectations.

Retailers continued to disappoint, even after January's spate of profit warnings: Woolworths (-8.8%) saw Australian executives resigning and cut its dividend. Shoprite (+4.9% in Feb, -9.7% YTD) rebounded when it published its 1HFY19 after a profit warning in January. Naspers spun out MultiChoice which joined the Top 40 on 27 Feb - with the first trade at R95, it traded up 11% to close the month at R105. SA precious metal stocks (Impala +55.7%, Sibanye +36.7%, Northam +14.4%) were among the best performing stocks in February underpinned by an increase in the PGM basket prices, led by palladium (+22.6% ytd, +66% since July '18). SA Resources (BHP +10.6%, Anglo American +8.9% and Sasol +7.3%) also outperformed buoyed high by commodity prices. Richemont rallied by 17.8% due to increased risk appetite following improved US-China trade talks. Hyprop fell by 13.9% with investor concerns around its Edcon exposure.

In February, SA equities had net foreign outflows of USD 0.5 bn whereas SA bonds had a net outflow of USD 0.1 bn. Cumulative inflows to EM bonds and equities YTD are now \$18.7 bn and \$23.4 bn, respectively. Standard Bank and Capitec were the most bought stocks by foreigners and FirstRand and AB InBev were the most sold stocks.

The Bloomberg commodities index ended February 2019 +0.8% higher led by palladium (+15.1%), iron-ore (+14.9%), Brent (+6.7%) and copper (+6.6%), while agricultural futures including wheat -12.4%, white maize -9.7%, yellow maize -8.3% and coal -6.3% lagged.

The Assegai fund rose 8.15% during February, chiefly due to the fund's overweight position in resources. Key contributors were long positions in Impala (+3.3%), Sibanye (+2.2%), Richemont (+1.7%), African Rainbow Minerals (+0.9%) and Kumba (+0.9%). Long positions in EOH, Fortress B and Sappi detracted most from performance during February.

Exposure to the banking sector was increased this month, to take advantage of a pullback in certain stocks in the sector. The long position in Property was trimmed and the short position in Telcos increased.
